
Saturday, December 3, and Sunday, December 4, come down to Casey Theatre at the Fine Arts Center at 3:30 p.m. The Glee Singers, Alumnae Chorus, Chamber Singers, Handbell Choirs, and the Instrumental Ensemble are prepared to serenade you through a cold winter's night—and maybe even beg for some figgy pudding!

A mix of traditional carols, Middle English melodies, pop Christmas canticles, and other songs will be performed both nights, such as works from Benjamin Britten's *Ceremony of Carols*, "Christmas (Baby Please Come Home)," "Fum Fum Fum," and more.

Free festive photos will be provided in the atrium with Christmas props and a holiday background. The family photos will be taken by Karina Hornbaker ('17) throughout the intermission, and prints for a Christmas card or keepsake will be available online after the event. There will also be chances to financially support the Glee Singers during intermission: seasonal refreshments—a hot cocoa bar, homemade pastries, candy—will be available for purchase, along with other snacks. You can also buy copies of our previous albums, preorder a calendar featuring our members, and buy a copy of a book written by one of our directors, Dr. Heather Josselyn-Cranson. Themed prize baskets will be raffled off as well!

General admission tickets are \$15 for the public; \$10 for seniors, students, Regis faculty, staff and alumni; \$5 for ages 12 and younger; and free (with ID) for Regis students and Lifelong Learning at Regis College members.
